When did your life change after encountering someone you didn't know or didn't

expect?

What helped you be opened to that change?

Explore the power of God's healing in vv. 31-37.

How has your life opened others to experience God?

Read again Isaiah 35:4-7a

What do you notice about this story as you read/hear it this time?

How is this a word of hope to the exiles in Babylon/any exiles?

How would you proclaim your hope in God to someone in need?

What images and phrases would you use?

Read again James 2: 1-17

What do you notice about this story as you read/hear it this time?

What are the acts of faith expressed in this reading?

Why is it hard to not show partiality to the rich and powerful of the world?
