at 10:00am today.

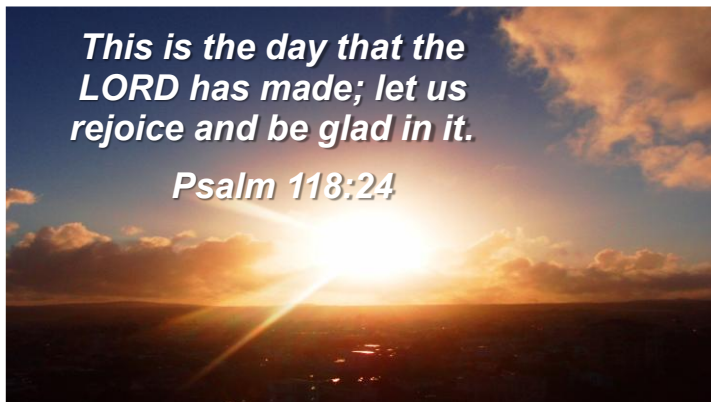
Kids under 5 will hunt eggs in
